“Best Hand” Fundraiser



Basics of the game: Get the “Best Hand” of five cards (determined by poker hand rankings).

- Participants purchase a numbered entry form (cost - \$20) redeemable at the Trade Show for a “Starter Hand”, consisting of two cards.

ENTRY FORMS ARE BEING SOLD BY MEMBERS OF THE KRPA BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

- **The highest ranking “Best Hand” wins \$500!!**
- In order to obtain additional cards, participants must interact with vendors to collect vendor coupons. Each vendor has unique pre-printed coupons to issue to participants that have visited their booth. Interaction is required between participants and vendors. **Participants may only use one coupon from each vendor!**
- In order for participants to acquire five playing cards, they must visit 15 different vendors and obtain each unique vendor coupon.
- These vendor coupons must be submitted to the dealer.
 - Dealers are assigned to participants based on their number.
 - When the participant has five unique vendor coupons, they will submit those to their specified dealer.
 - The dealer will verify that the five coupons have only been utilized only once; then, they will allow the participant to draw one card per five coupons verified.
 - The dealer will write the participant number on each card dealt.
- A maximum of three additional playing cards can be drawn!
 - **EXCEPTION:** Each participant has the opportunity and is encouraged to visit more vendors to acquire additional vendor coupons. If participants acquire 10 additional vendor coupons (after the original 15), they will be able to draw a sixth “bonus” card from the dealer. The dealer will write the participant number on this card.
 - Once a participant has drawn 4 additional cards, the dealer will mark that hand CLOSED. No additional cards may be acquired.

NOTE: only five of the six cards may be utilized to make a “Best Hand”.

“Best Hand” Fundraiser Timeline: 11:00 am – 2:00pm

Upon entering the Trade Show, participants should locate the dealer representing their participant number and present this numbered entry form for the drawing of their two-card Starter Hand.

- Vendor coupons will be picked up at 2:00 pm.
- Last cards will be drawn from dealers at 2:30 pm.
- Participants must submit their “Best Hand” to their dealer by 2:40 pm. Only 5 cards may be submitted!
- Winning Hands announced by 2:45 pm.

Hand Rankings

- Best five cards shall be played per hand; all must have the same participant number on the face.
- No Jokers or Wild cards will be utilized.
- Suits are neutral.
- Best Hand determined by included ranking.
- Cards must be present to win.
- Judges decisions on game rulings and awards are final.

Prizes: \$500 \$250 \$125 \$75 \$50

- Ties will be determined by number of participants involved in tie.
 - Example: 2 participants have the best hand, the top two prizes will be combined and split between the two participants.... $\$500 + \$250 = \$750$ divided by 2 = each participant awarded \$375.
- Prize money may be donated back to the KRPA Scholarship Fund.
